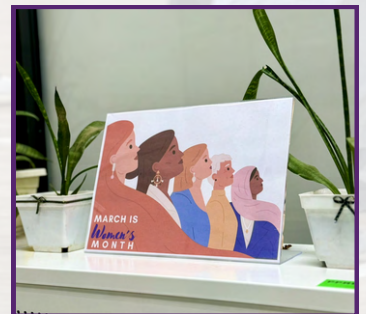

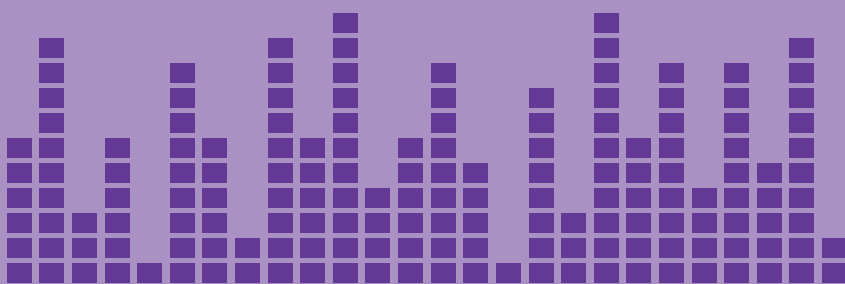

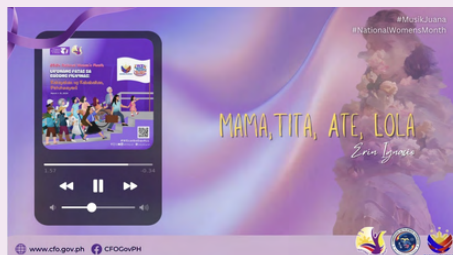


MUSIKJUANA SONGWRITING CONTEST
