

Magna Carta of Women

Republic Act 9710

The MCW is a human rights law that seeks to eliminate **DISCRIMINATION** and **PROMOTE THE RIGHTS** of Filipino women especially those in marginalized sectors of the society.

MCW was signed into law by former President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo in 2009.

Some salient features of the Law:

1



MCW protects women from all forms of violence.

2



MCW provides comprehensive health services and information covering all stages of a woman's life cycle.

This includes granting of 2-month leave benefits with full pay for women employees who undergo surgery caused by gynecological disorders.

MCW provides equal access and elimination of discrimination in Education, Scholarships, and Trainings.

MCW prohibits expulsion, non-readmission, non-enrollment, and other related discrimination of women and faculty due to pregnancy out of marriage.

4



MCW guarantees equal rights in all matters relating to marriage and family relations.

5



MCW prohibits discriminatory and derogatory portrayal of women in media and film.
