Services for Elderly Clients



CFO recognizes the special needs of senior citizens through a separate priority lane.

To complement national legislations that provide special assistance and privileges for the elderly, CFO also delivers programs that offer a friendly and less rigorous transaction during their pre-departure registration, such as the following:

a. Emigrants who are 60 years old and above are only required to register with CFO and are exempted from attending the mandatory Pre-departure Orientation Seminar. Their registration can be done personally or through an authorized representative at the CFO main office or at its satellite offices in Clark, Pampanga and in Cebu. Senior citizens have also the option to register at the CFO desk at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport during their departure bound for their respective home countries.

b. A separate and a priority lane in the CFO registration area is being provided to senior citizens.

c. Priority is rendered to elders who are partners or married to foreign nationals during their attendance

to the mandatory Guidance and Counseling Program (GCP), specifically to the one-onone interview portion of the GCP with the Guidance Counselors.
