# 2018 Statistics on Philippine International Migration



# Message

The number of international migrants worldwide has continued to grow rapidly in recent years, reaching 272 million, according to the 2020 World Migration report of IOM. The Philippines, a major country origin of migrants – both temporary and permanent, is a large contributory to this.

The growing number of Filipinos leaving the country every year, in search of better life and opportunities abroad has cross-cutting policy implications affecting their welfare and well-being, as well as national and local development. Evidence-based data on migration is critical for policymakers, researchers and

government program implementers to effectively manage migration of Filipinos, protect their welfare, as well as harness migration's developmental gains, and address its challenges. We have seen this recently, with the COVID-19 pandemic, where overseas Filipinos were affected, and thousands need to be repatriated back to the Philippines.

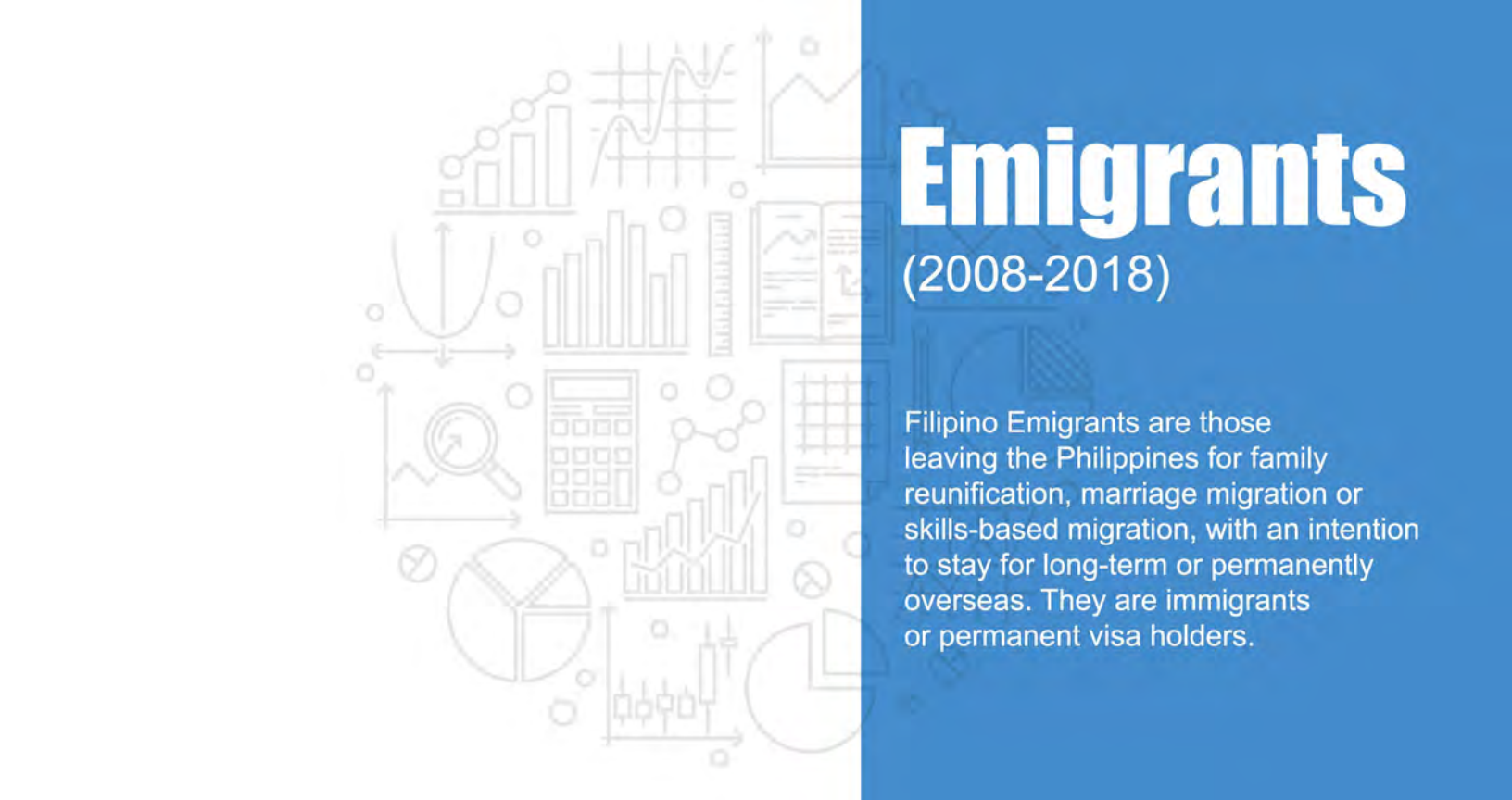
This indeed proves that international migration is both a global opportunity and challenge, steadily growing in scope, complexity and impact. In recognition of this, along with our strong commitment to Philippine Open Data and Freedom of Information, we are pleased to release the 2018 CFO Statistics on Philippine International Migration. educational exchange participants, and other pertinent information concerning diaspora philanthropy, anti-human trafficking and assistance to nationals, and Philippine schools overseas.

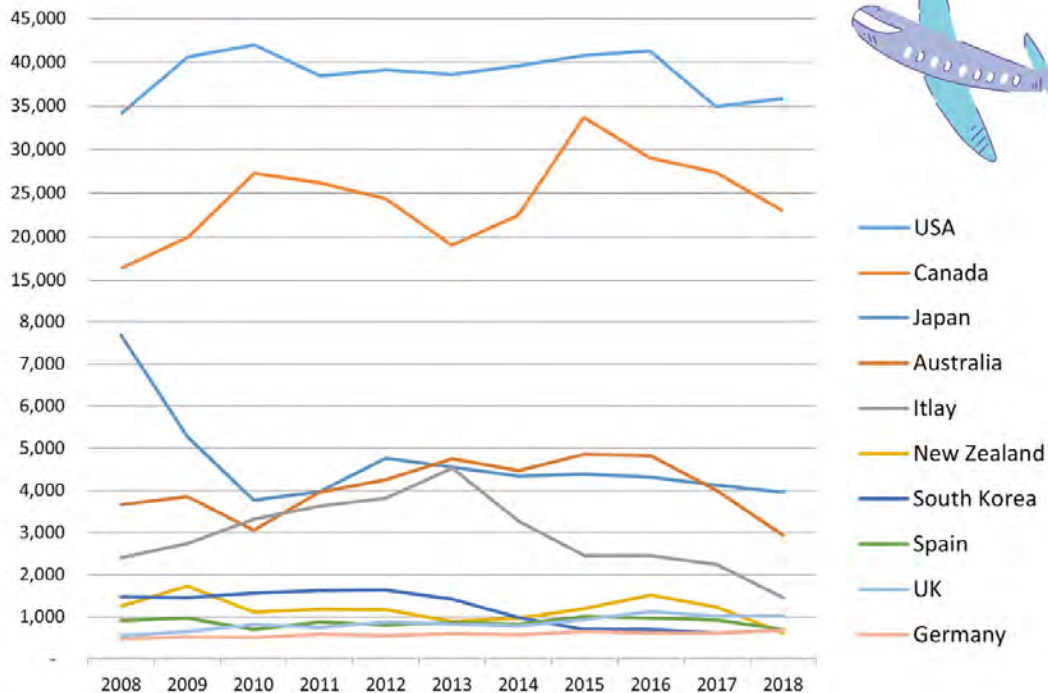

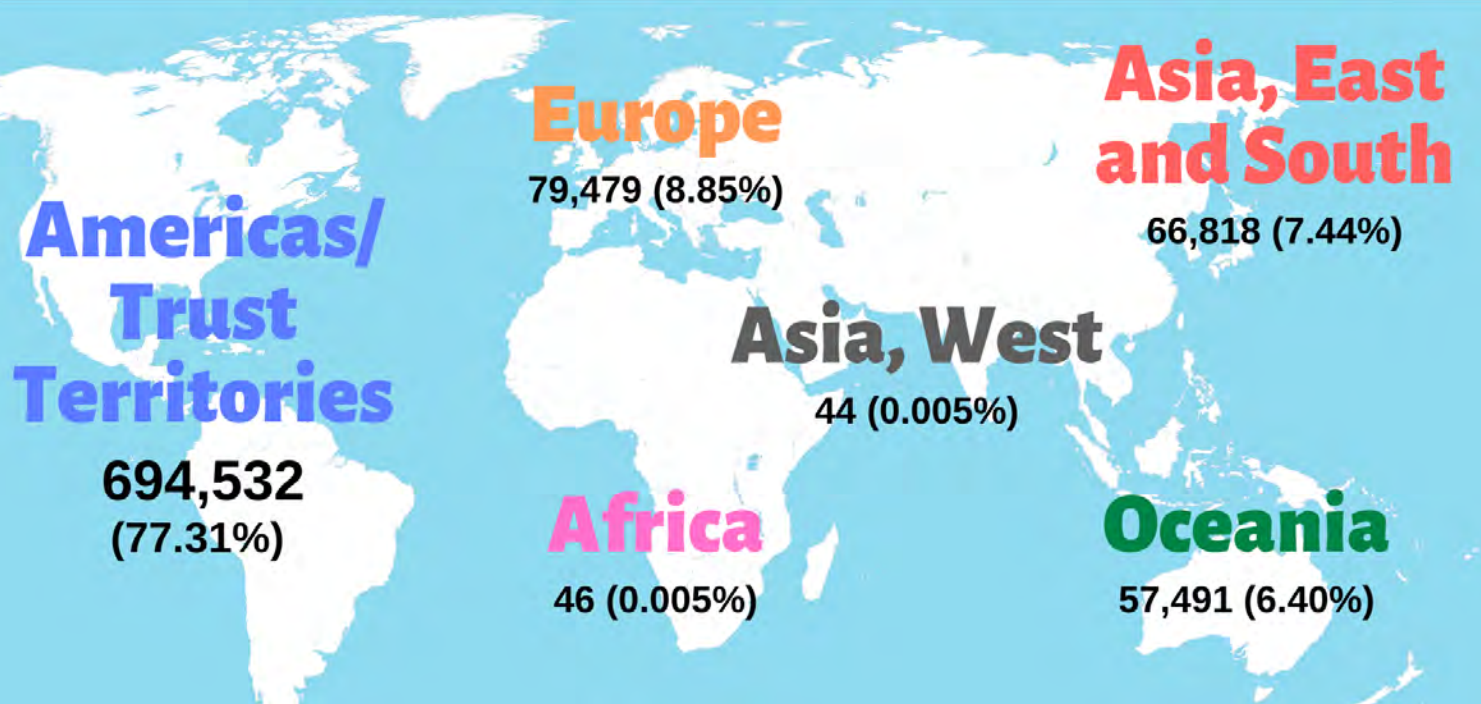

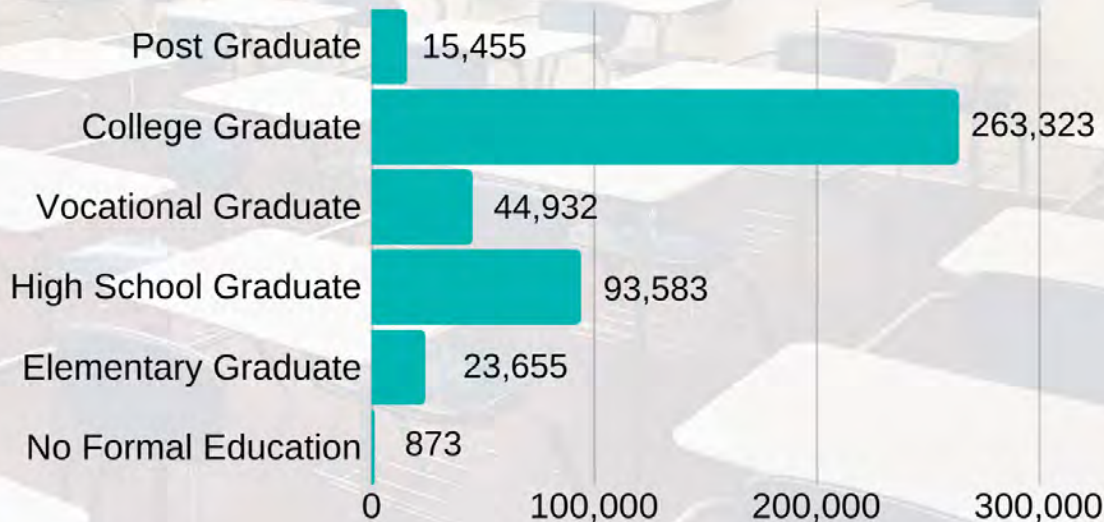

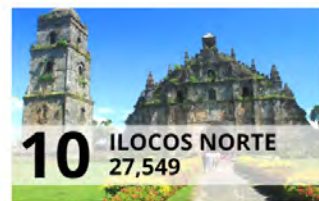
# Educational Attainment

(2008-2018)

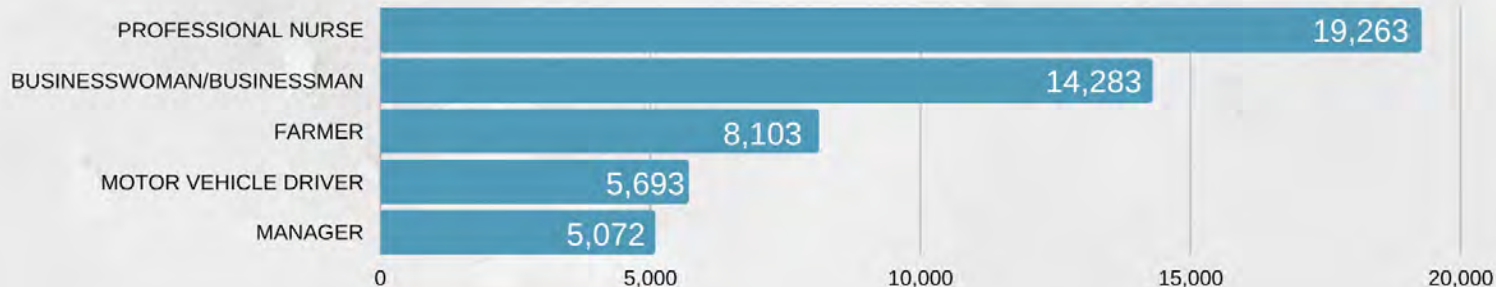


# Top 10 Province of Origin

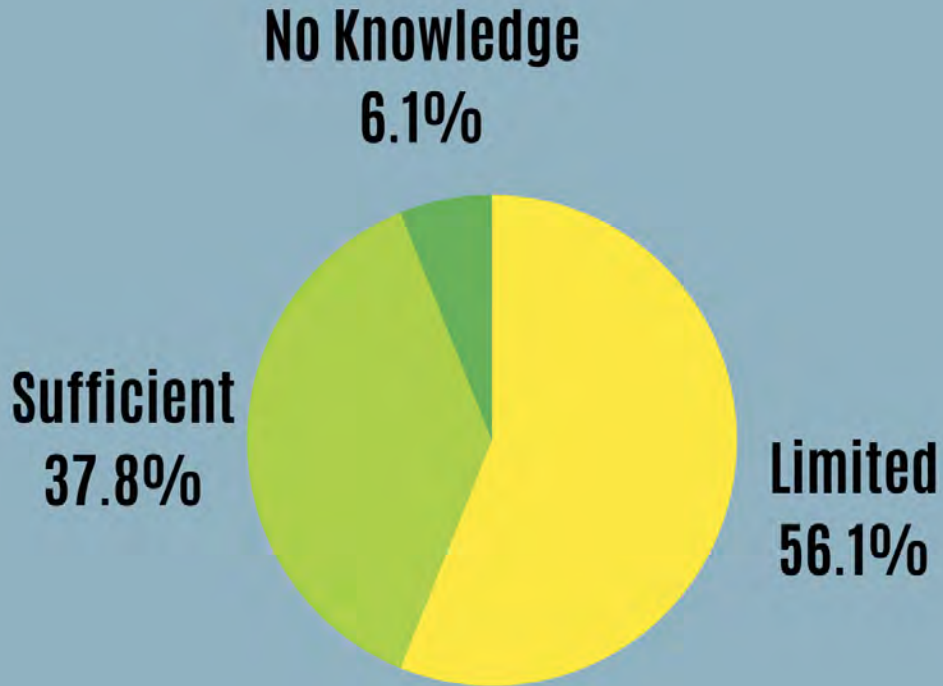

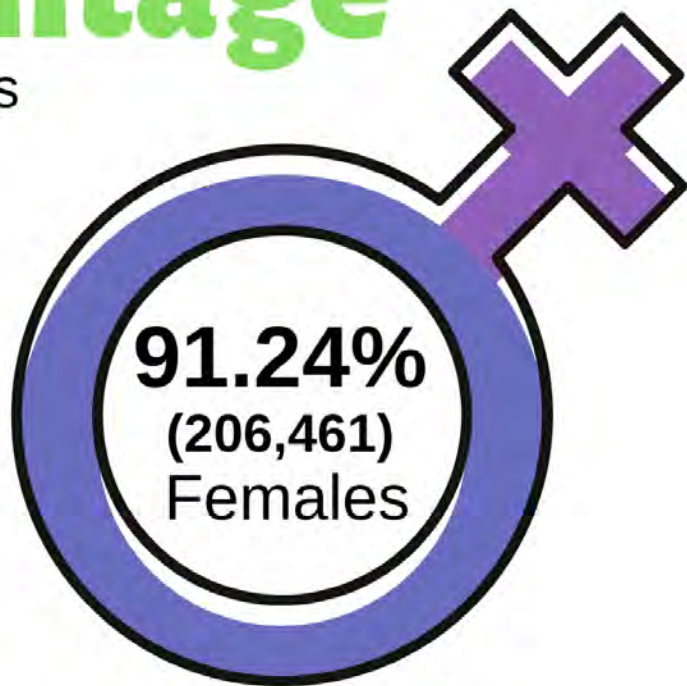
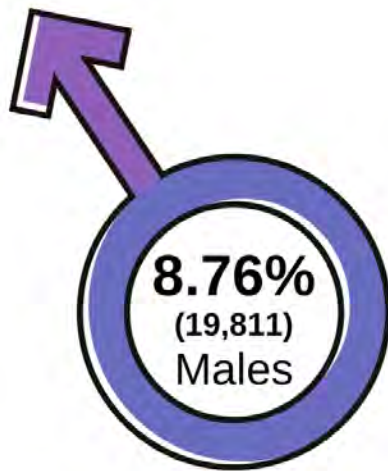

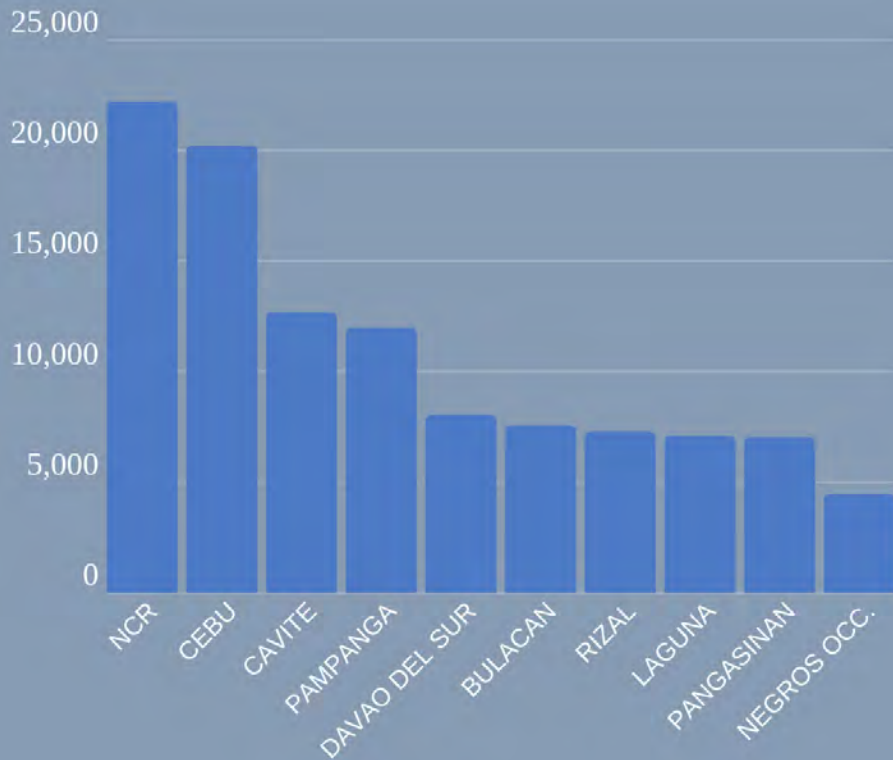

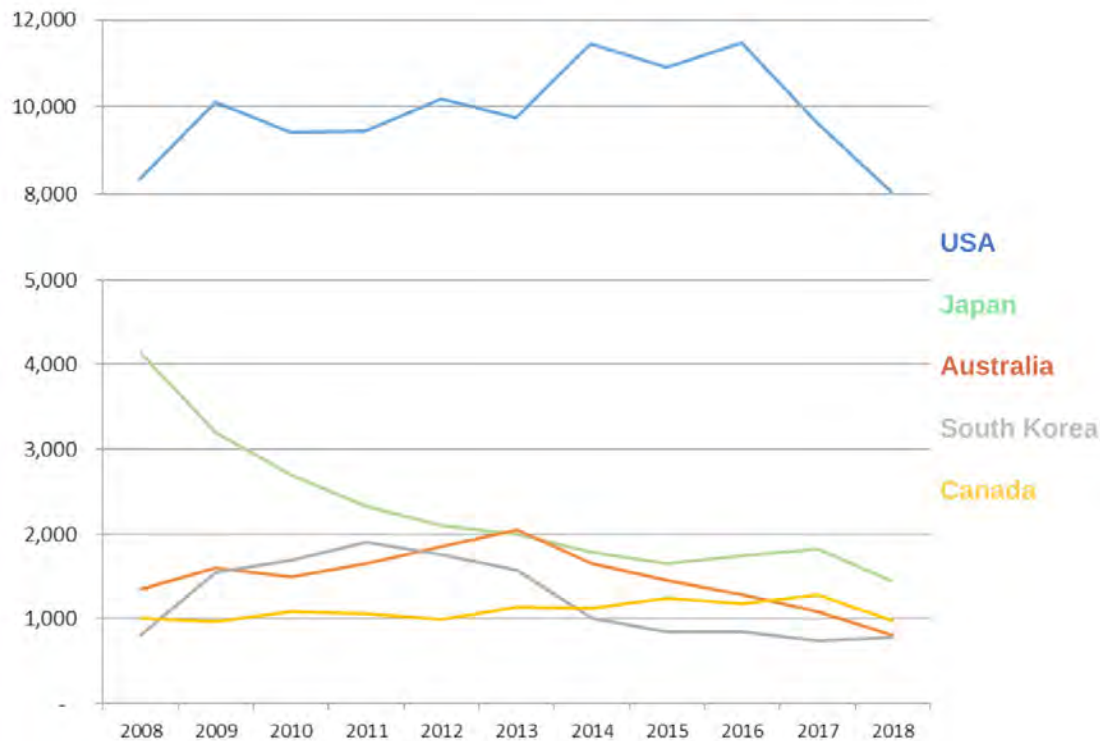
# Top 10 Province of Origin

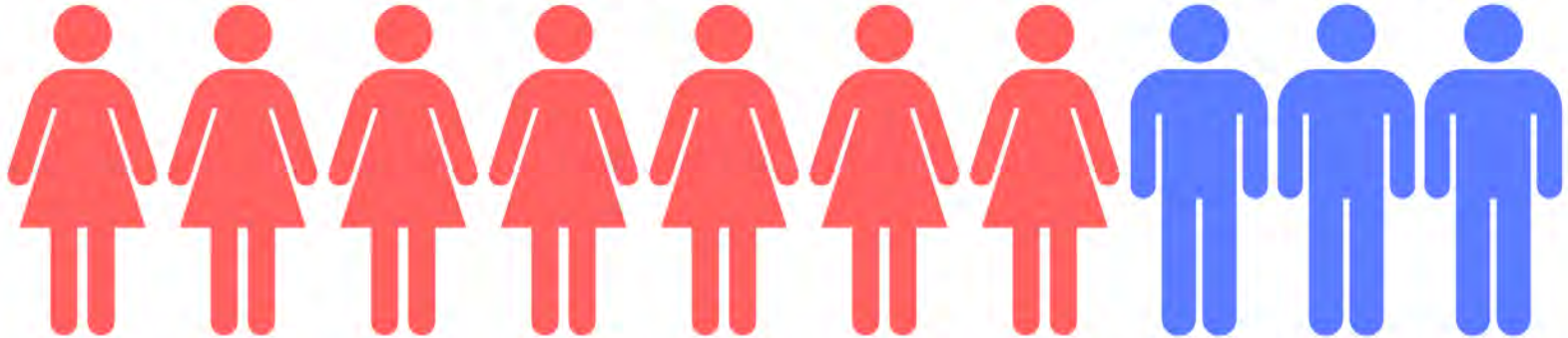

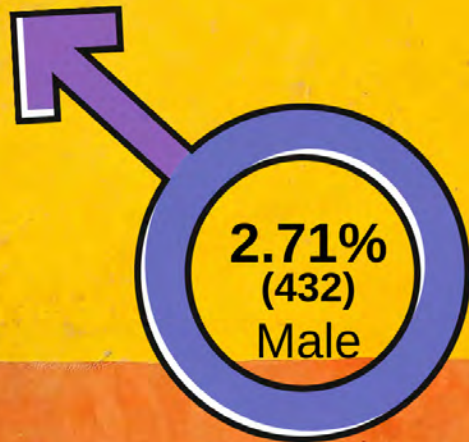

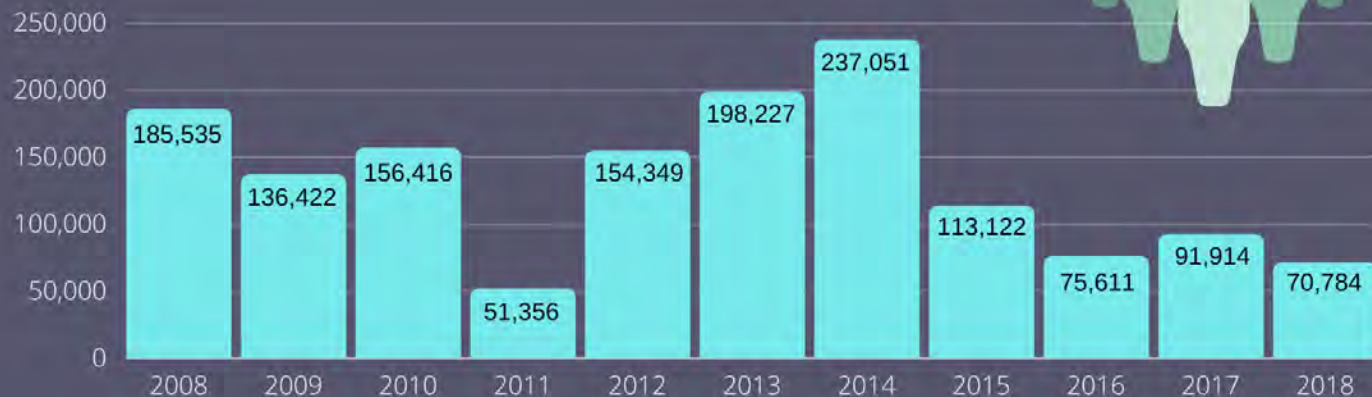

## (2008-2018)

Philippine Schools Overseas (PSOs) are private educational institutions that are fully or partially-owned and/or managed by Filipinos. These schools, which follow the prescribed Philippine curriculum, are required to secure permits to operate and be recognized both by the Philippine Department of Education and its counterpart institution in the host countries. Dependents of overseas Filipinos who studied in PSO's can easily reintegrate into the Philippine educational system upon their return to the home country.

(S.Y. 2018-2019)

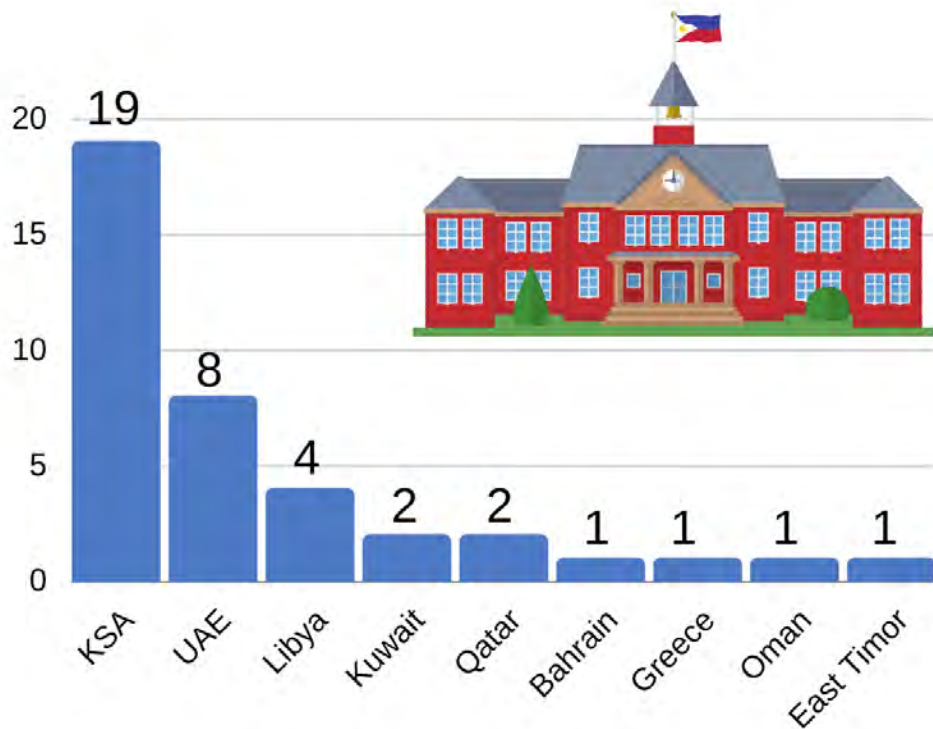

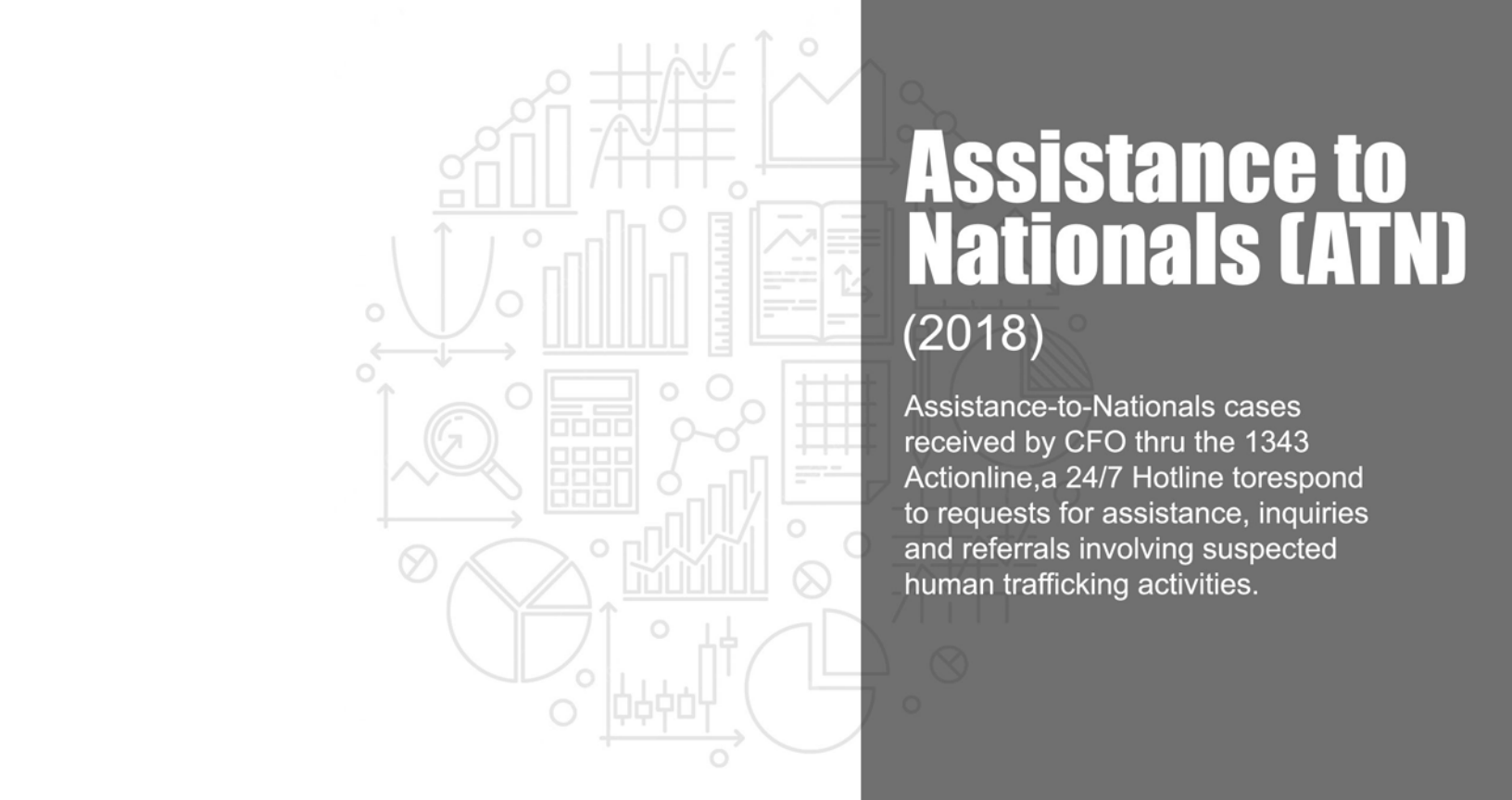


# Number of Philippine Schools Overseas per Country (SY 2018-2019)

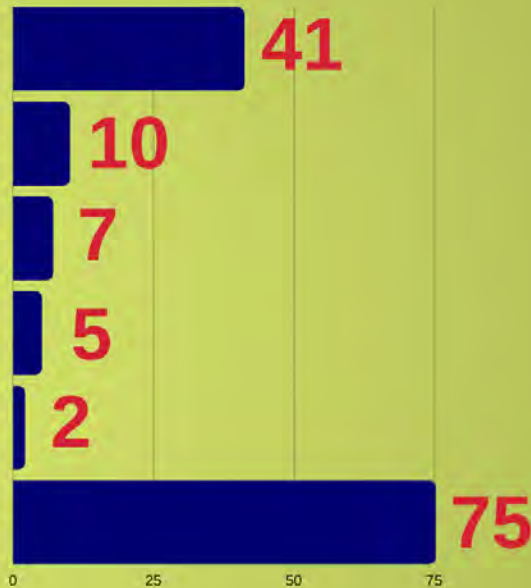
