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INTRODUCTION

There are over 250 million international migrants worldwide, with the number increasing each year. It is evident that international migrants contribute to the global economy and establish cultural and business exchanges between the host and home countries. A significant number of these migrants originates from the Philippines. Over the past decades, Filipinos have taken to working and relocating abroad in search of a better life and opportunities to support and provide for a brighter future for their families and loved ones.

Their increasing number has resulted to significant implications for the government to craft policies pertaining to their health, safety, and welfare. There are also significant research and development implications to effectively study the phenomena of Filipino migration, manage its advantageous effects, and resolve its problems.

In recognition of this, and in line with our commitment to Philippine Open Data and Freedom of Information, we are pleased to release the 2020 Statistics on Philippine International Migration. This compendium contains data on Filipino emigrants, marriage migrants, cultural and educational exchange participants, and other pertinent information concerning diaspora philanthropy, anti-human trafficking and assistance to nationals, Philippine schools overseas, and other migration-related data of the CFO.

We, at the Commission hope that this publication containing relevant information on Filipino migration will be of value to you and your organization to see the trend of international migration, and as a tool for informed and evidence-based decision-making or as a guide to raise greater awareness on the realities of international migration.



Emigrants

Filipino Emigrants are those leaving the Philippines for family reunification, marriage migration or skills-based migration, with an intention to stay for long term or permanently overseas. They are immigrants or permanent visa holders.

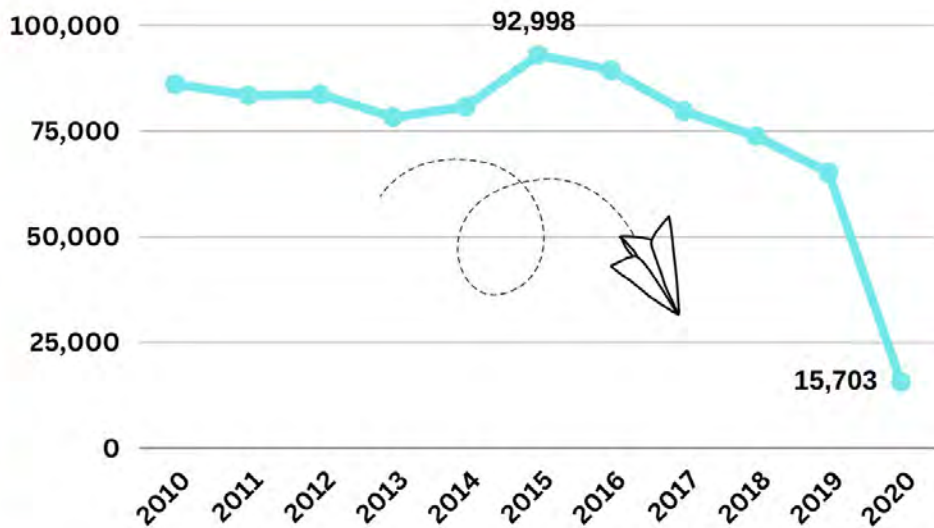

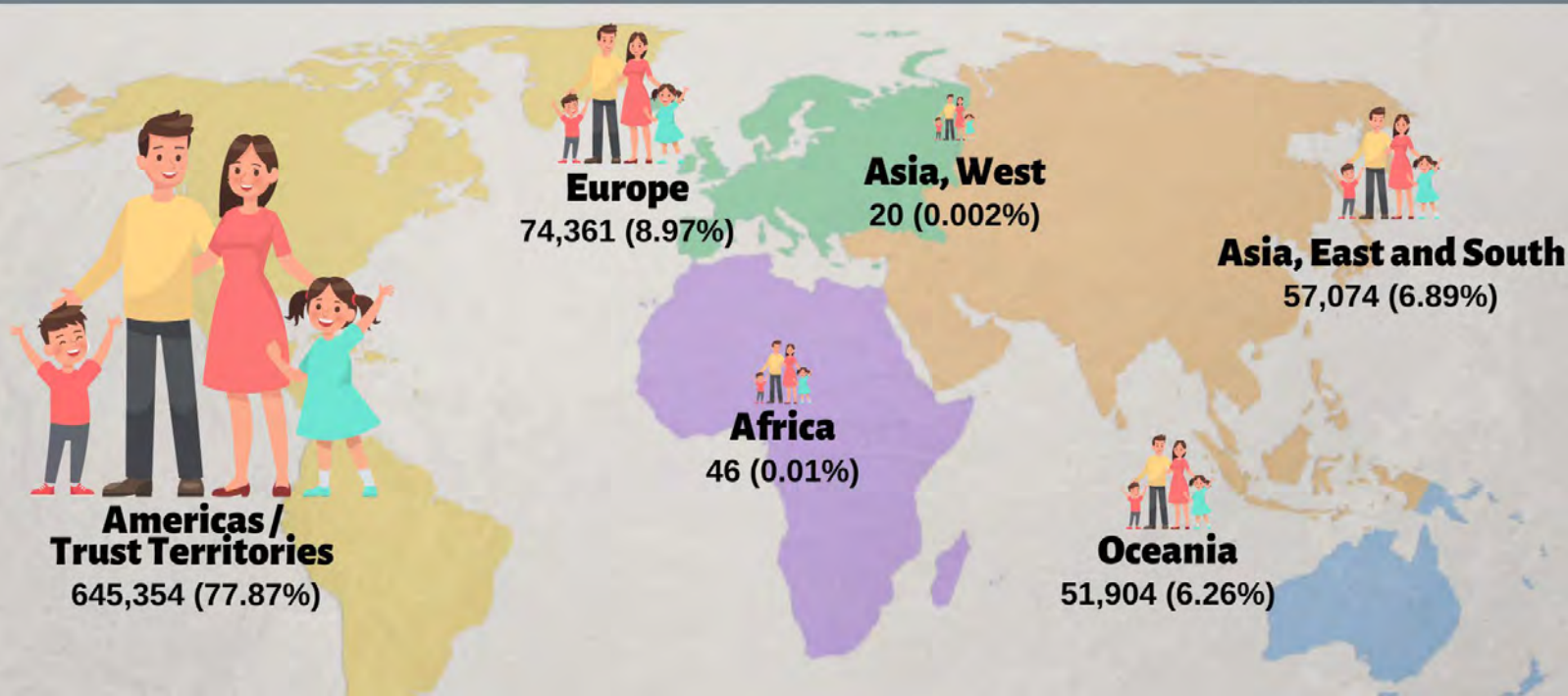


Migration Trend

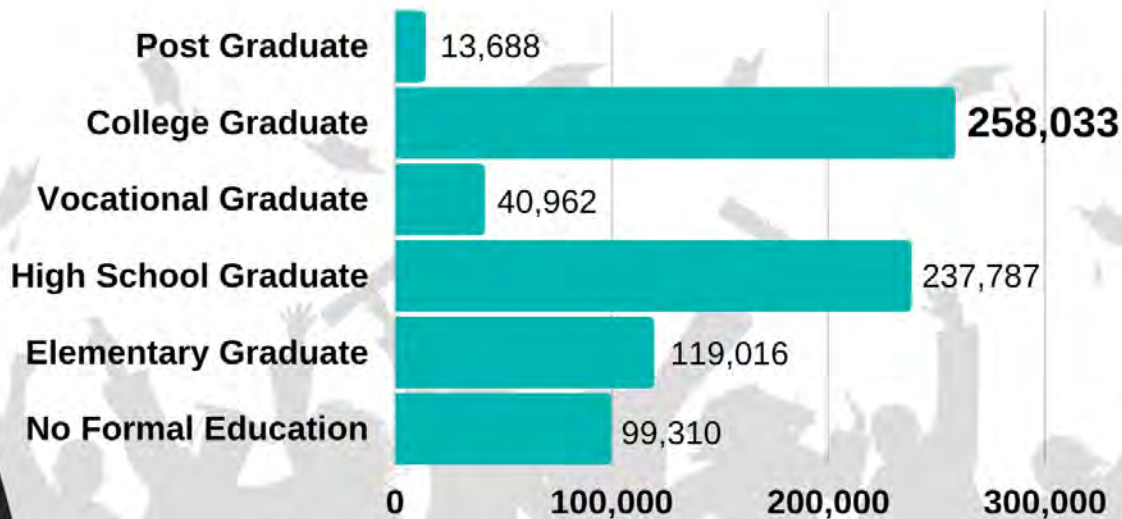

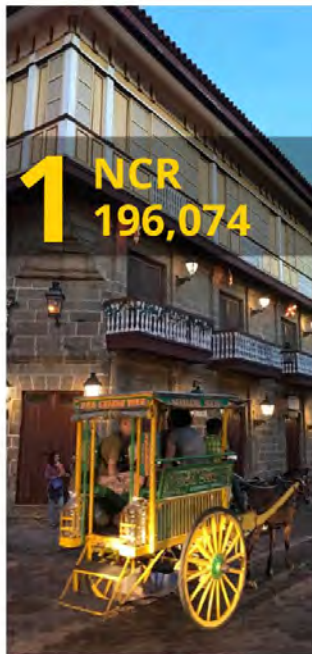
Educational Attainment

(2010-2020)

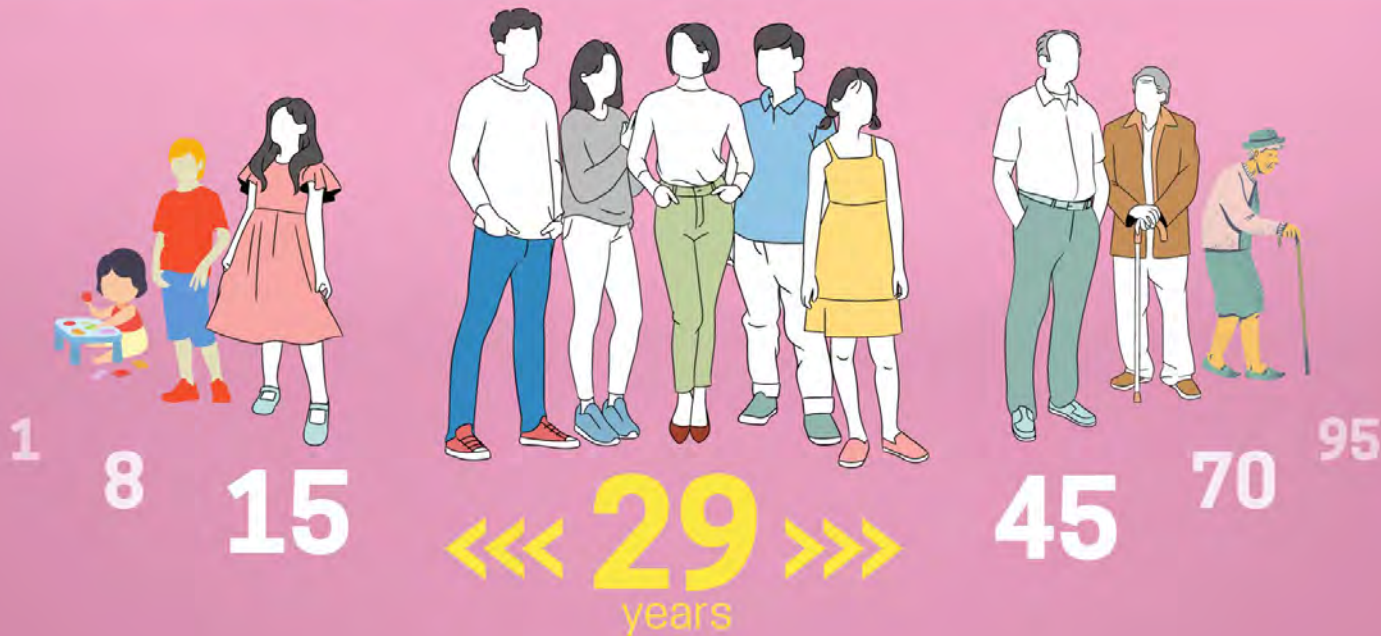


Top 10 Province of Origin

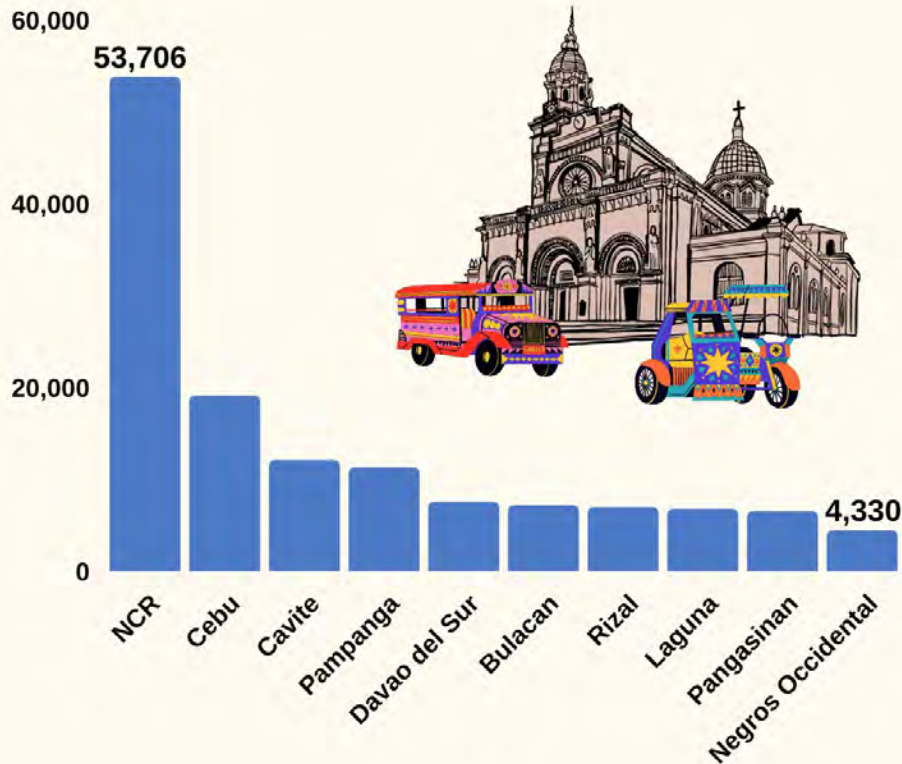

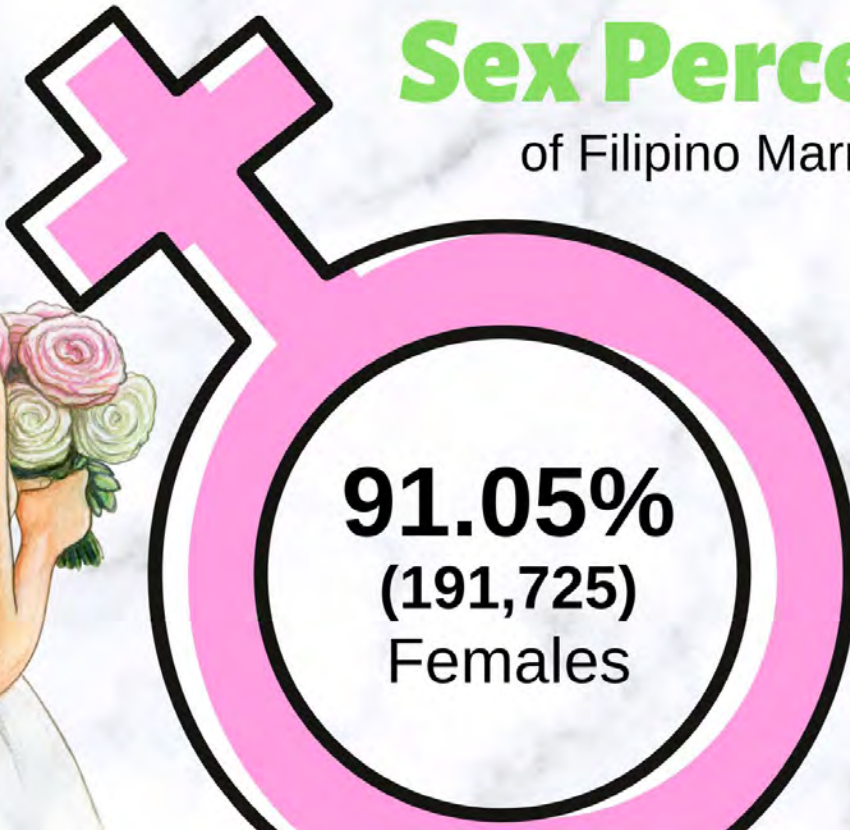

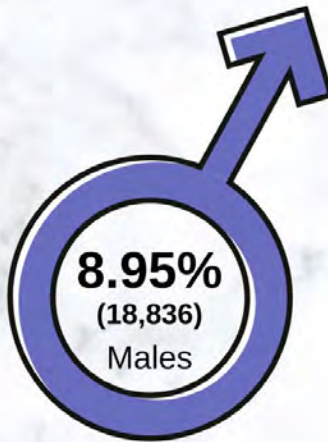


Sex Percentage

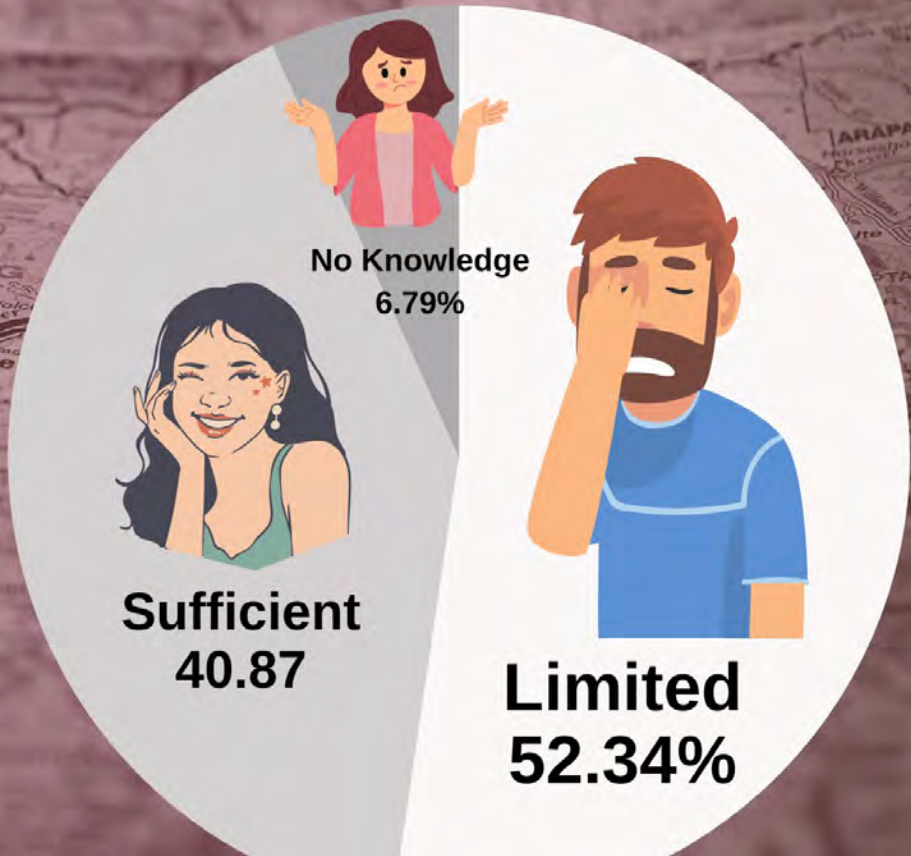

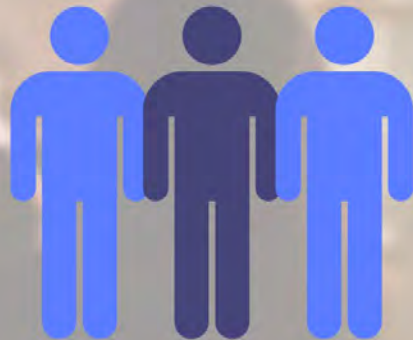

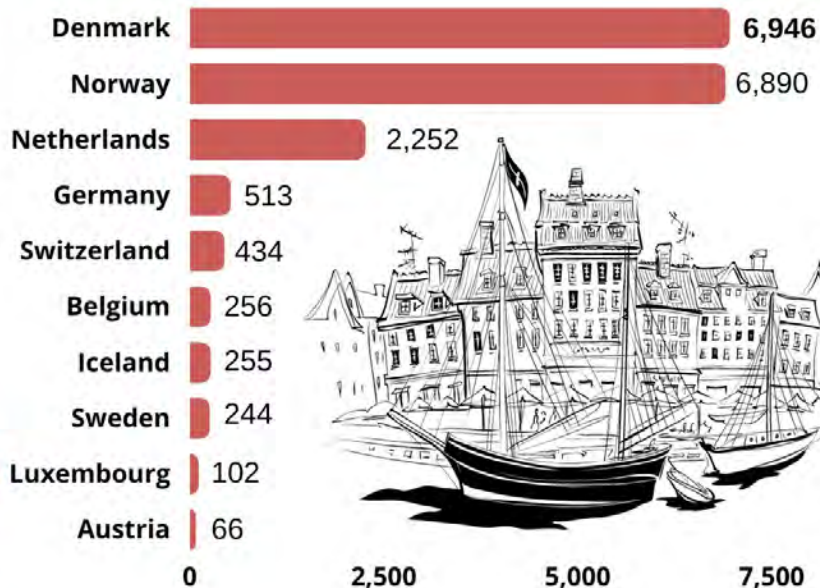

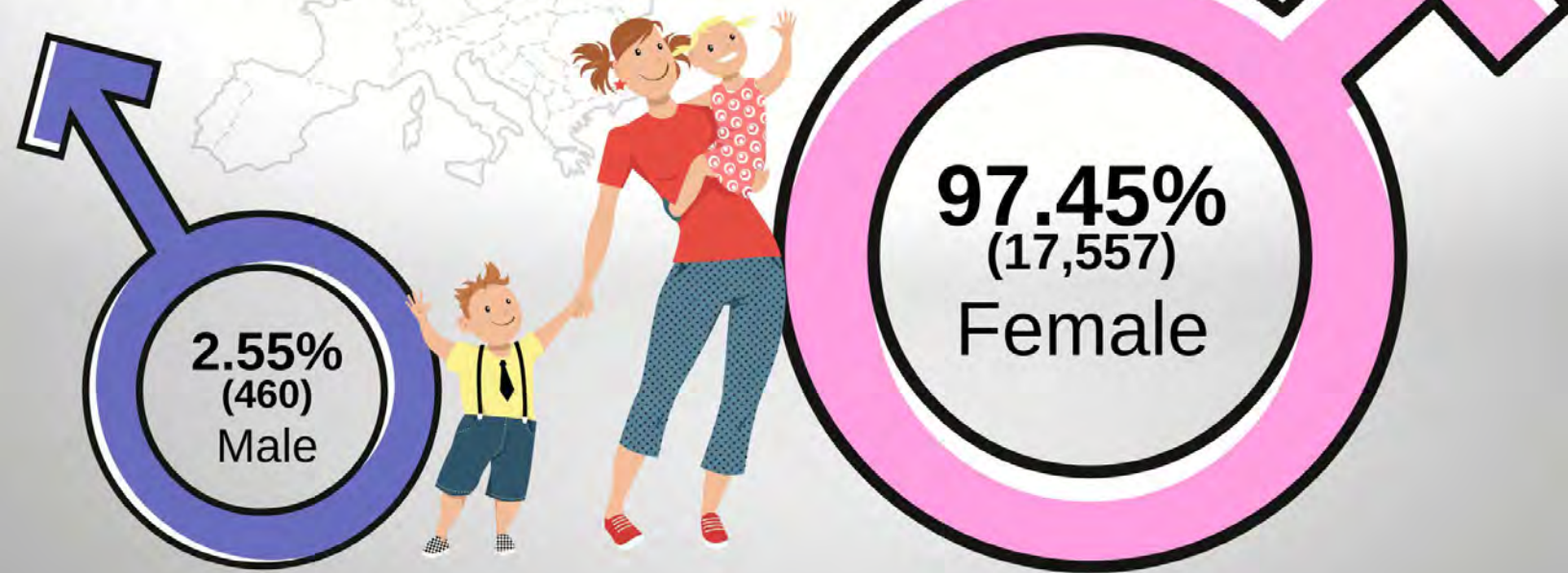
Top 10 Destination Countries

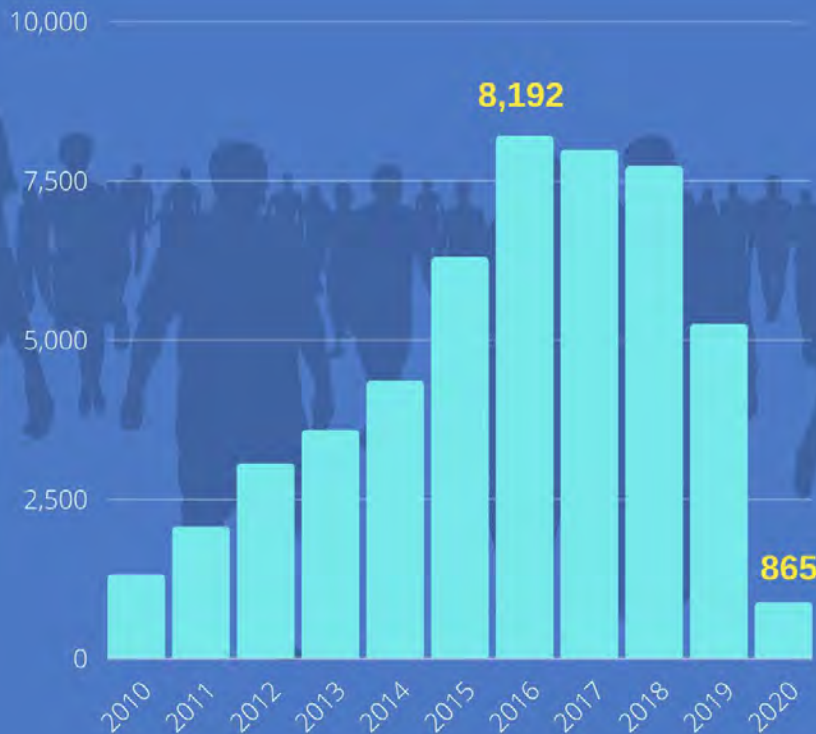

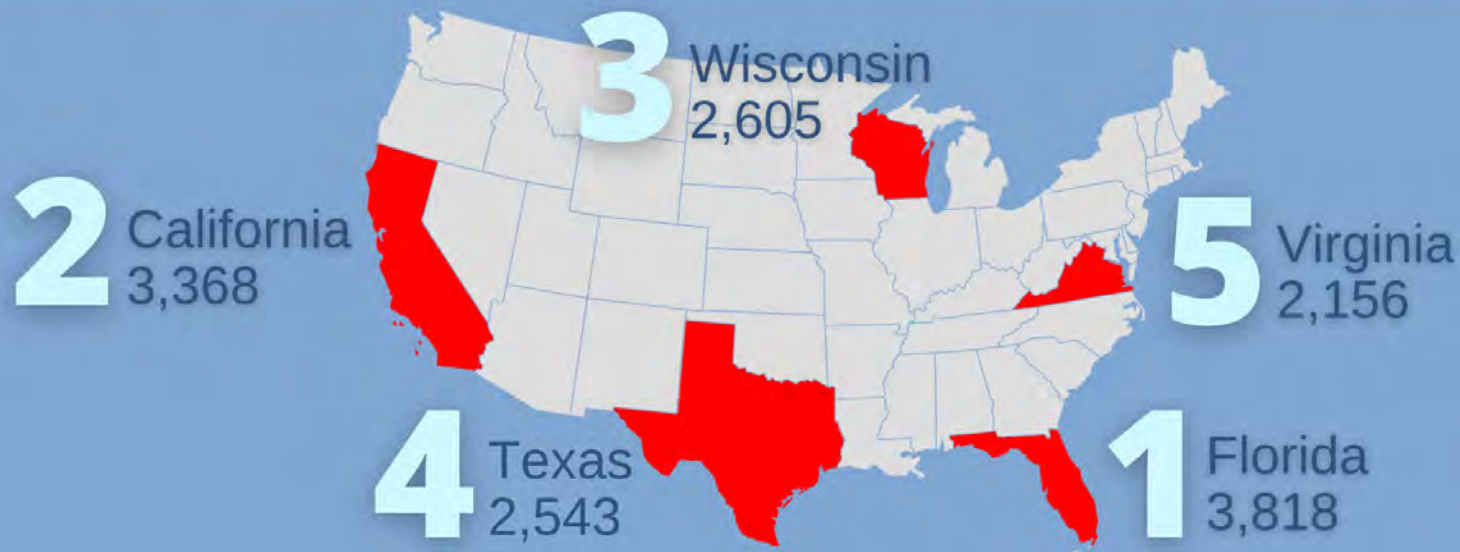

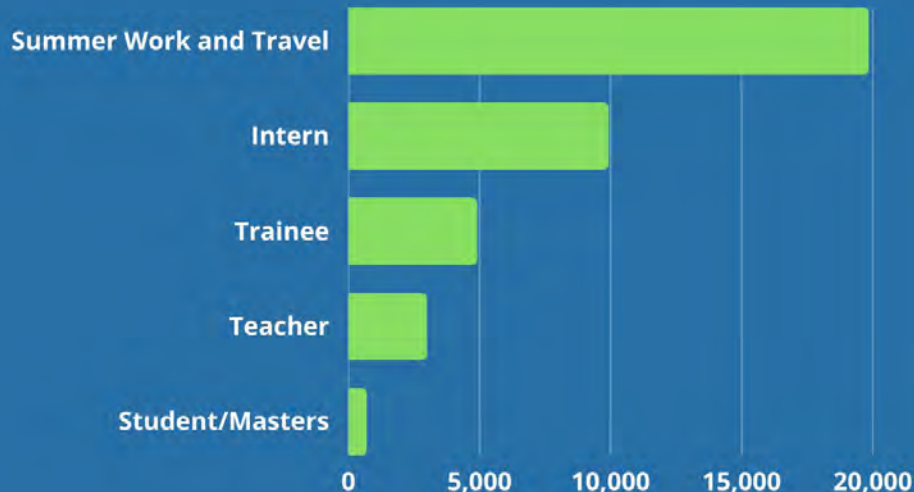
Top 5 Areas of Deployment

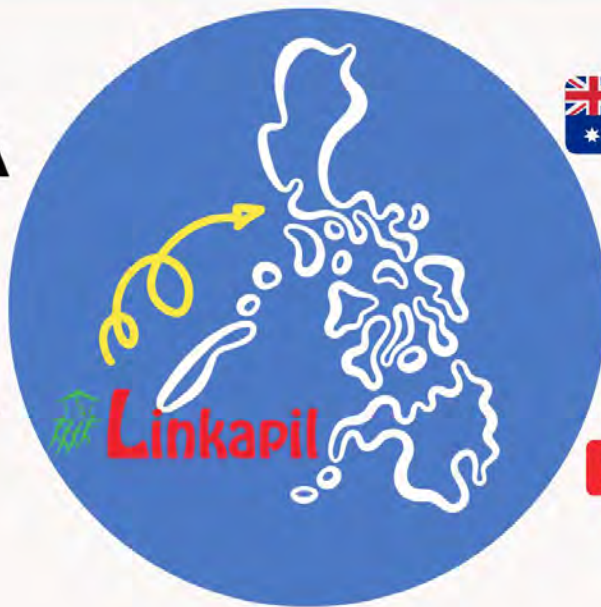

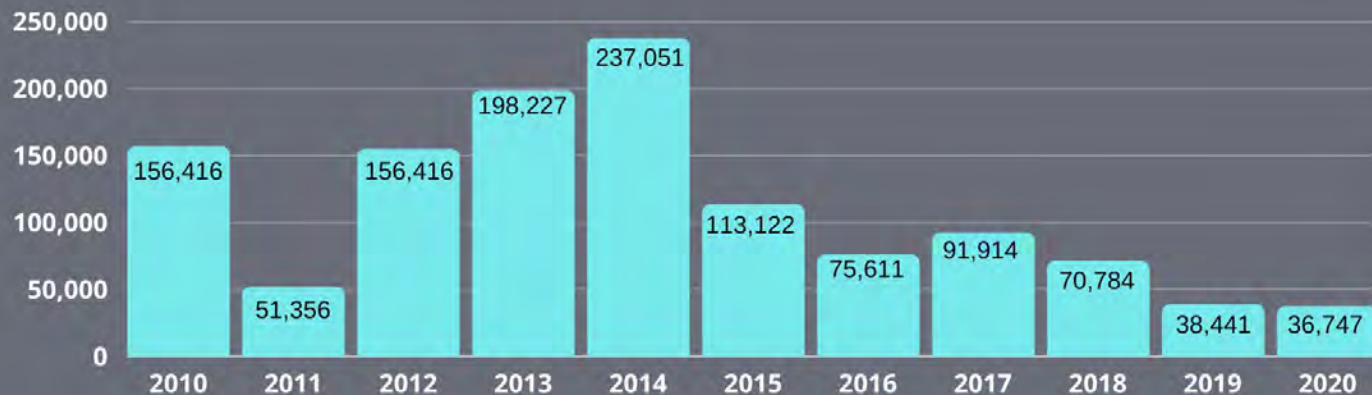

These schools, which follow the prescribed Philippine curriculum, are required to secure permits to operate and be recognized both by the Philippine Department of Education and its counterpart institution in the host countries. Dependents of overseas Filipinos who studied in PSOs can easily reintegrate into the Philippine educational system upon their return to the home country.
